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Women's Wear Apparel Construction Program (Wovens)

Women's wear wovens is considered the foundation of most fashion design education programs as women's bodies have distinctive curves that require more complex construction in comparison to other divisions of the fashion industry such as knitwear, children's wear and men's wear.

Imagine wrapping an acoustic guitar in paper compared to a wrapping a cardboard box. In the case of men's wear or children's wear the shapes are more angular and require fewer curves to accommodate fitting the body. In knitwear the fabric stretches which simplifies the shape needed to wrap the guitar. Therefore, if you have women's wear woven apparel construction skills as a foundation you can easily transfer that knowledge to other sectors of the fashion industry.
