

Criteria for Pattern making

Information: should be written clearly on the grain line as follows:-

<u>piece name</u>	<u>cut info</u>	<u>project name</u>
your name		size (8)

-information for SELF, FUSE and LINING should be written in a different colour. Example:
SELF (black) FUSE (red) LINING (blue)

<u>Front</u>	<u>cut 2 self</u>	<u>skirt design</u>
Cici		- 8-

Seam Allowance

- All hems and darts that do not come to a 90 degree angle must have a jog
- All seam allowances are 1cm unless otherwise stated. (0.5cm for 1/2 scale)

Notches

- All seam allowances and hems more than 1 cm should be notched.
- Double notches are reserved for back pieces with few exceptions

Interfacing

- Interfacing pieces do not have notches.
- Interfacing pieces are generally 0.3cm smaller than self (can vary depending on thickness of fabric or type of interfacing)

Punch holes

- 2cm in for dart points
- 0.3cm in and down for patch pockets
- 0.3cm in for diamond darts and 2cm down or up from the tip

Accuracy

- All pattern pieces need to be verified at every seam that will be sewn together to ensure accuracy

Presentation

In an A4 envelope you should include your **PLAN**, **PATTERN** and **DESIGN** (illustration)

Example
